

## Python Programming Workshop

### Turing test

```
import random
print("Hi, my name is Ariel")

# ask the user their name
 = input("what is your name? ")

# welcome them to the program
print("Great to meet you", , "lets have a conversation")

# start by asking an open ended question
print("")

# let them type in a response
input()

# this is a list of possible questions
questions = [
    "How interesting. And then what?" ,
     ,
     ,
    
]

# repeat the next bit several times
for i in range(4):

    # choose a follow up question
    q = random.choice()
    print(q)

    # let them type in a response
    input()

# when finished, say goodbye
print("I have to go now. It was great talking to you", )
```

**Extension:** `random.randint(1,10)` will give you a random number between 1 and 10. Use that to make it ask a random number of questions, not just 4
